This survey has brought the fact out that majority of frontline colleges in Arts are affiliated to the University of Delhi. In that list of frontline colleges this also came out that Assam's oldest college Cotton College has not been able to compete with the best in the country. It is definitely a matter of concern for everybody associated with education in the state. According to the survey conducted by "The Week", out of a total of fifty colleges the position of Cotton College is a poor 41st.
